

**BRIEF REPORT ON 2<sup>ND</sup> ONLINE MEETING OF UIP, IPC & IPU ON 1<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2022 AT 03:00PM**

1. The Meeting was attended by officials from Central Water Commission, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India, Irrigation & Water Resources Department, Mizoram, Public Health Engineering Department, Mizoram and Mr. Zoremnuana Ralte (Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Mizoram)
2. The Meeting discussed method of assessment of Ultimate Irrigation Potential (UIP), Irrigation Potential Created (IPC) & Irrigation Potential Utilised (IPU) where Ministry informed that UIP, IPC & IPU data of Mizoram are received in completed data and not in seasonal data.
