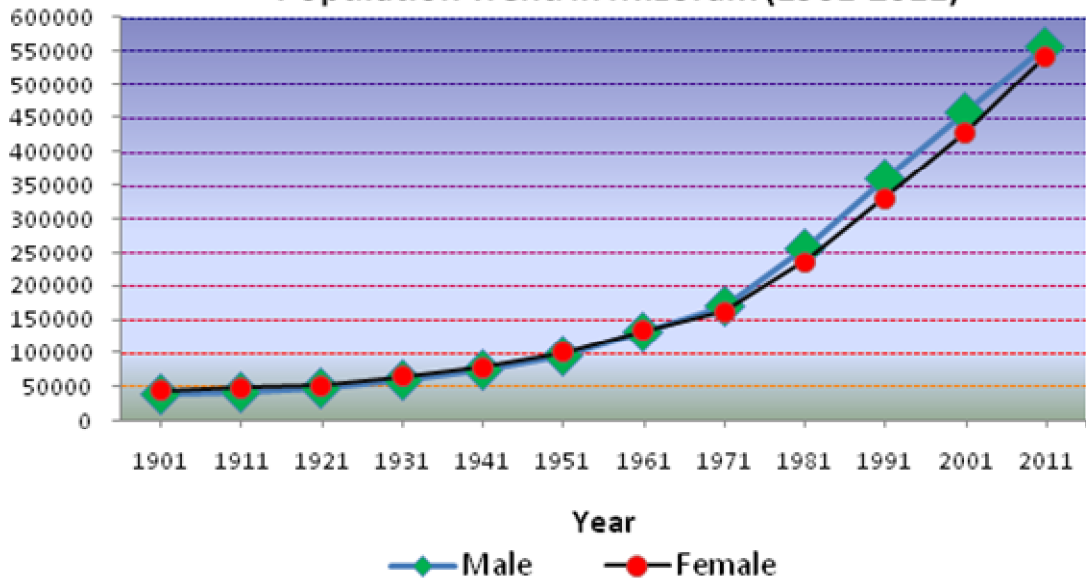

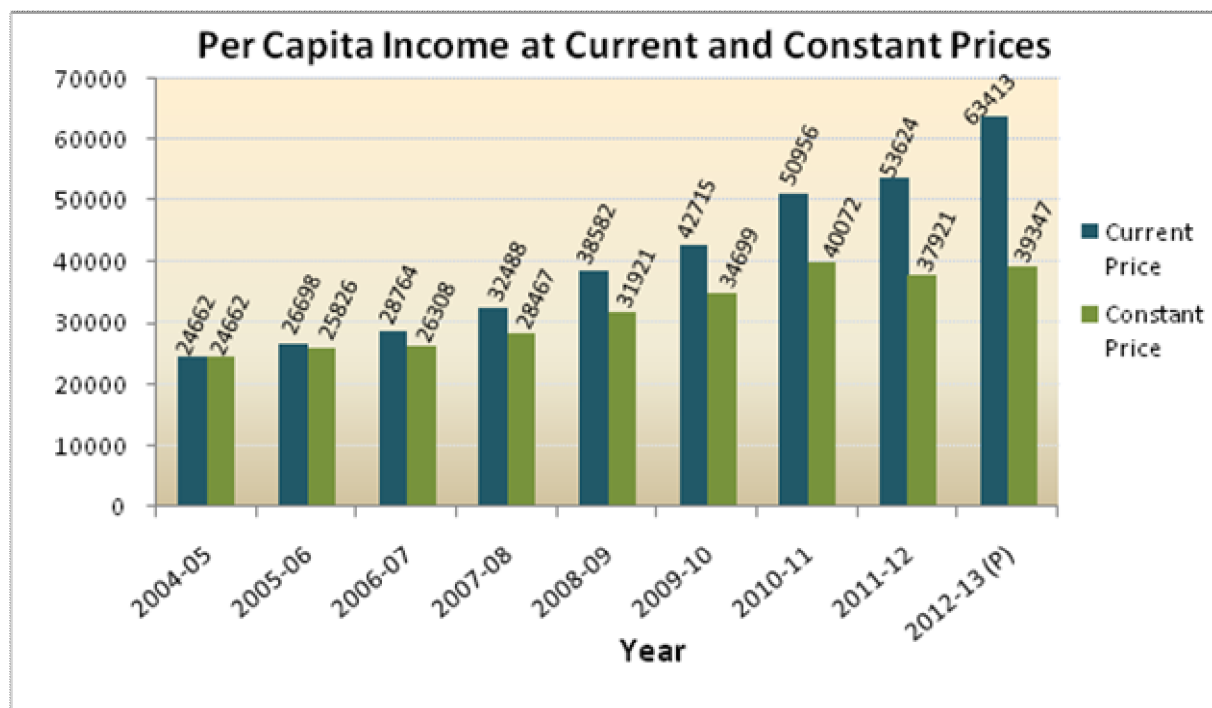


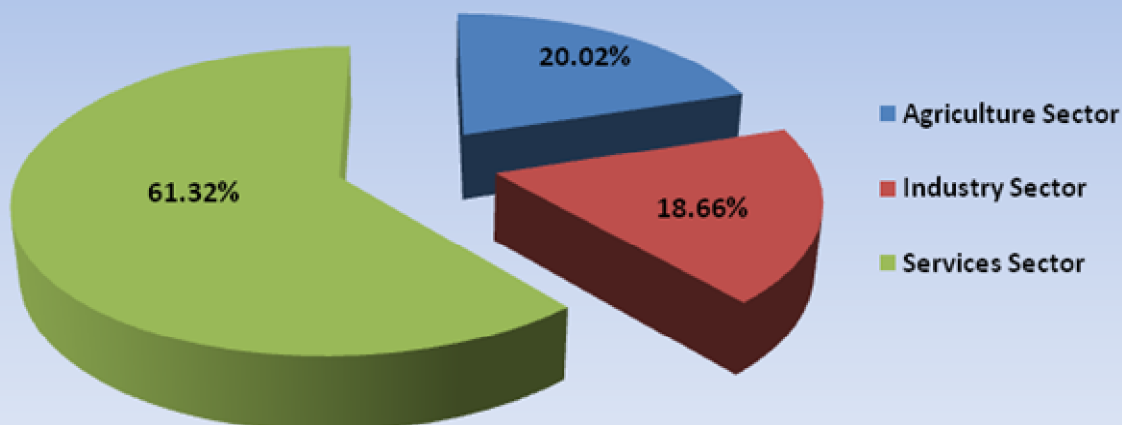

Sectoral Share of GSDP at Current Prices 2012-13 (P)

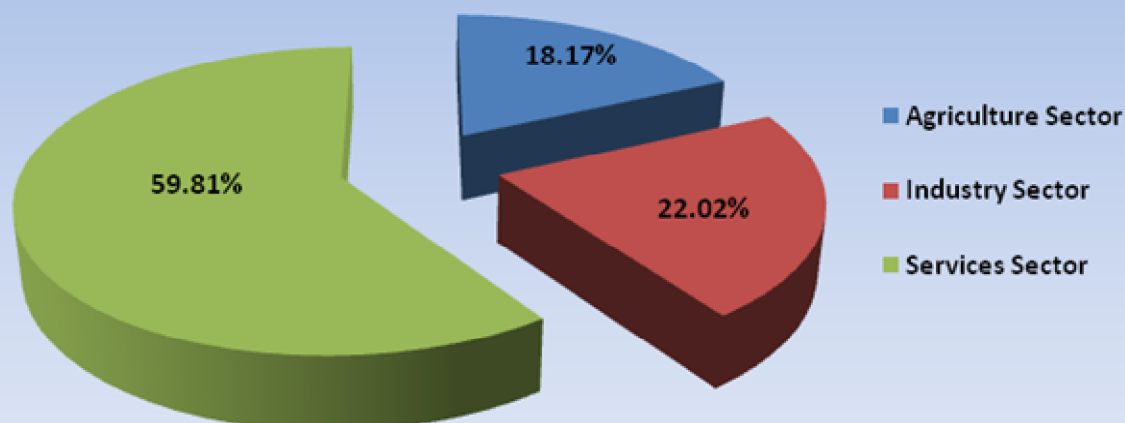
